## Scholarship Opportunities

**RCA Hope for Addiction Scholarship** - Due to the impact of the opioid epidemic in the United States and the ever-expanding need for well trained professionals to help battle addiction, Recovery Centers of America (RCA) launched a scholarship program to encourage college and university students to do their part in the fight against the addiction crisis affecting our nation. We established the RCA Hope for Addiction Scholarship to offer financial assistance that will help undergraduate and graduate students pursue and finish their degrees with the intention of helping people struggling with addiction. **Hope for Addiction** - Recovering addicts who are willing to commit to not using drugs or alcohol for the rest of their lives may qualify for this scholarship program. At the time of publication, the Hope for Addiction program gives awards of \$1,000 for students attending community college, four-year university, trade school or technical school. Awards are granted quarterly. Applicants must be 27 or younger, and they may be asked to take a drug test proving their sobriety at the time of application and during the academic year. <https://www.addictionhope.com/>

**Landmark Students of Recovery Scholarship**- Thousands of students on college campuses across the nation struggle with addiction while managing class loads, social lives, and in some cases holding down part-time jobs. It is estimated that more than 30% of college students who use drugs or alcohol meet the criteria for a substance use disorder, and according to the U.S. Surgeon General, only 1 in 10 of these individuals will wind up seeking treatment. College can often be the first time that individuals are free from parental supervision, placed in a high-stress academic environment coupled with peer pressure and a high degree of personal responsibility for balancing work, school, and academics.
